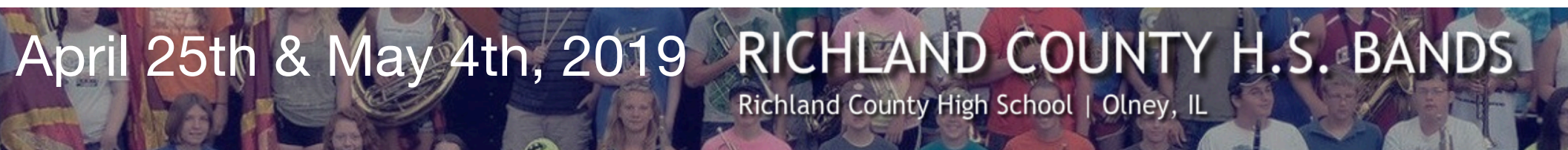

Individuals Plan FastPass+ Experiences in Advance

Things to Consider:

- Most groups use this plan.
- Individual group members can begin reserving access to FastPass+ experiences **30 days** from your group's arrival date (valid Theme Park tickets required).
- Before linking tickets in the My Disney Experience profile, assign each member of the group a ticket

card by writing their name on the ticket card. Felt-tip permanent markers work best. If you're adding name stickers to the ticket cards, please place the stickers on the front (color) side of the card.

- When in doubt during the planning process, always return to the "Planning Page" of your My Disney Experience account.

Follow these steps to get started with Disney FastPass+:

1. Be sure to have your ticket card or Ticket ID number in hand.
2. Go to [StartYourDisneyExperience.com](#)
3. Once you have a My Disney Experience account, select My Reservations and then "link a ticket or pass"

- The Ticket ID number can be found near the lower left corner of the ticket.
- Enter your Ticket ID number in the field and select your name as the ticket user.

Tip: Before beginning, assign each member a ticket by writing their name on a ticket card.

4. Reserve Access to FastPass+ Experiences

- Please keep any scheduled events in mind when making FastPass+ selections.
- Not all options may fit with your group's schedule. However, FastPass+ times can be modified based on availability after confirming initial selections.

About MyMagic+ & My Disney Experience

MyMagic+ is the ultimate planning tool. Be sure to download the My Disney Experience App for your mobile device to check attraction wait times, make dining reservations and more.

Please note that some features of MyMagic+ and functions on My Disney Experience are only available to Guests 18 and over. Guests 13-17 may register and access certain features of My Disney Experience such as FastPass+. Children under 13 are not permitted to register and create a My Disney Experience account.

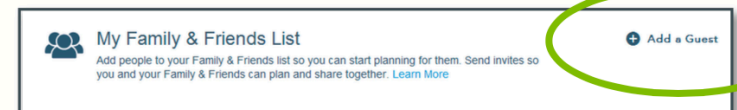

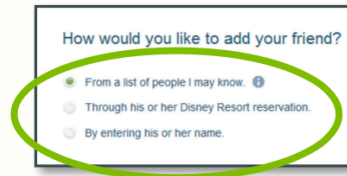
Step 1

First, select the **+Add a Guest** link on your Family & Friends list page.



Step 2

You'll have three options for adding family members and friends to your **My Disney Experience** account.



1. From a list of people I may know:

Send an invite to people who are managed by or connected to Guests on your Family & Friends list.

2. Through your friend's Disney Resort hotel reservation:

Locate people using their reservation information:

- Confirmation number and last name on reservation, or
- Last name, *Disney Resort* hotel, reservation phone number and arrival date

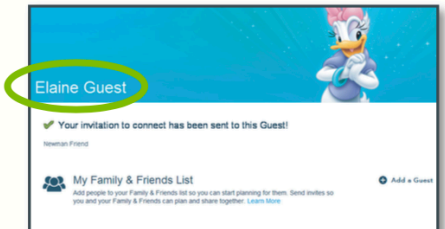
3. By entering his or her name:

If you haven't added friends yet or aren't making plans with a reservation party, simply enter a name.

Step 3

After invitations are sent successfully, a confirmation message will appear on your **Family & Friends** page.

- You'll see your friend's name added to your **Family & Friends** list with the status "Invitation Pending."
- Any Guests you have invited to plan and share will need to accept the invitation in "My Disney Experience."



Step 4

Once completed, start planning your fun together.

Times Not to Fastpass

1. Any Day: 9:00-10:00 (waist of a Fastpass)

2. **June 1st (no-ride times):**

- BAND = 11:30-1:00
- CHOIR = 10:15-11:45

3. **June 2nd (no-ride times):**

- BAND = 12:00-3:30
- CHOIR = 2:00-3:15



Fast Pass Directions

Recommended Fastpass times

1. Over lunch times (12:00-2:00)
2. Over dinner times (5:00-7:00)
3. During parades that do not feature RCHS & fireworks



Tips for Disney World

1. Download two apps on your cell phone
 - ***Bob Rogers Travel***
 - ***Disney World Experience***
2. Register your Fastpasses 30-days in advance
 - Stay clear of performance times for band & choir (listed on pages 9 & 10 in the arrows)
 - Don't Fastpass between 9:00-10:00 am. Lines are shorter. It would be a waste of a Fastpass
 - Use your Fastpasses before 3 PM to get new Fastpasses in the evening for free using your *Disney World Experience* app
3. Visit the popular rides during parades & firework displays, and immediately after the fireworks displays. Lines are shorter.
4. Visit the continuous attractions during the afternoon (The Hall of Presidents, Monster's Inc. Laugh Floor, etc.) when ride lines are long. There is virtually no wait, and is air conditioned!
5. Pre-order your meals on the *My Disney Experience* app

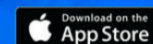

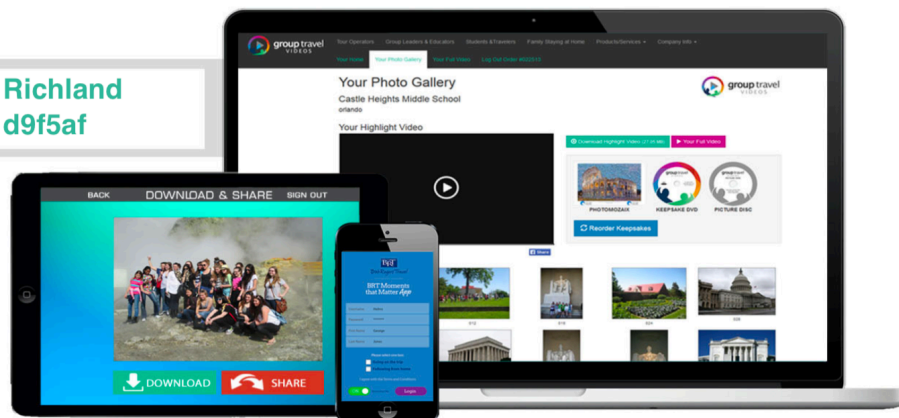
